



Relationship between Snainton Woodworking Supplies and the Club

Snainton Woodworking Supplies (SWWS) is a business that is of great benefit in supplying tools, equipment and accessories to professional and amateur wood workers, wood turners and craft workers.

Snainton Woodturning Club is an independent Club that exists for the benefit to all those interested in woodturning or related activities.

Presence of SWWS and its products, wood, meeting hall and other facilities is of great benefit to the Club and its members. In addition, SWWS should, in theory, benefit from the presence of the Club members purchasing items when they attend as individuals at the monthly Club meetings, or at other demonstrations held at SWWS. However, it is surprising that only a handful of members appear to avail themselves of these facilities.

SWWS allows the Club to hire its facilities monthly for a nominal fee of £20 per meeting and £8 for tea at the interval. For these fees, the Club is fortunate to get access to a lathe, tables and chairs, tea, teapot, a water boiler, power, heating, and storage space for the Club's TV and tripod.

Members need to be sensitive to the following aspect of the Club's relationship with SWWS:

- 1) Promotion, selling or purchase of Member's tools and equipment anywhere on the premises of SWWS (including the car park) or on the Club web site (which is linked to the SWWS web site) is strictly prohibited.
- 2) Demonstrators are not permitted to sell their products on SWWS premises. However, they are allowed to promote their products if these items are stocked by, or can be ordered through, SWWS.
- 3) If Club members have equipment or tools that they wish to sell, this should be done privately but **not** anywhere on the SWWS premises or Club web sites.
- 4) Club Monthly Meetings:
 - a) The side door of the meeting room will be opened at 1845 hr to enable the Committee and demonstrator to set up for the meeting.
 - b) On Club nights, please leave two car parking spaces nearest the main entrance for use by disabled members. On entry to the SWWS site, please drive slowly, for safety and to minimise dust. Also, do not obstruct the access road to the fields beyond SWWS premises.
 - c) The main doors will open at 1900 hr and the demonstration will start at 1930 hr.
 - d) The demonstrator will be asked to finish by 2130 hr, if possible, after which questions and announcements will be completed by 2140 hr. At the end, members are asked to stack their chairs at the back of the hall, and the demonstrator and Committee will clear and put away their equipment.
 - e) Normally, the building will be vacated and locked up by 2200 hr.
- 5) Shop Opening times during Club meetings:
 - a) 1900 until 1930 hr and during the Club tea-break, 2030 hr until about 2045 hr.
 - b) Club members are not permitted in the shop outside these times, unless accompanied by a member of SWWS staff.
