Club night, Thursday 2 June 2022.

Peter Howells gave an excellent demonstration on how to make a pierced vase with thin walls (around 5mm), turned on 4 axes. Similar to the photo attached.

We were using two ordinary webcams on the night and acknowledge a zoom in facility may help for some parts of the demos, again something we are researching.
