I visited another garage clearance last Wednesday, Ken Cook in Newby, Scarborough. I bought a number of chisels, pen kits and accessories, and some Australian wood blanks. Woodman lathe.

A good quality, very sturdy machine. Cast iron bed and stand, swivel head, electronic variable speed, 32" between centres, 8" depth. Accessories include various toolrests,



Supernova chuck with 3 sets of jaws, another chuck, a Jacob's chuck, faceplate and centres, flexible worklight. *Woodman* is a reputable Australian tool company – the previous owner was Australian. £500 o.n.o.

Axminster Trade CT-90H Dust Extractor

This is a very high quality dust extraction system, a professional standard machine. There is a large funnel on a stand that goes with it (worth maybe £30), which would be placed alongside the lathe, and a 4" connector hose. It has been superseded by another model, currently on sale at £560. I would suggest Ken would be happy with £175 - £200.



Record Sharpening Station WG250

This is a wet-grind sharpening system, with 10" wheels, one of which has a leather strop on it. There is a spare wheel as well. I think all the accessories are present. Still on sale new on Amazon, listed at £337. I think Ken would be happy with £80.



Proxxon fretsaw

A good quality fretsaw/scrollsaw from a reputable brand. The 36 x 18cm table can be tilted for mitre cuts up to 45°.

Still on sale new on the internet at £279. I think Ken would be happy with £80.

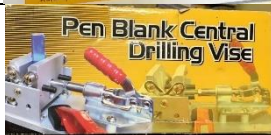
