Second Hand Equipment

I am going to see someone about a workshop clearance on Tuesday. As usual any smaller items I buy will appear in the club shop, but there are some larger items available. Please let me know if you are interested – again as usual, first come first served. I believe they are virtually unused. I will be negotiating prices with the seller on behalf of the Club.

- [Jet 1221VS lathe](#). On a stand, **12 21 VS** means it will turn a **12"** bowl, can take **21"** between centres, and is **Variable Speed** (60 – 3600rpm. It has an M33 drive, I think with a Nova SN2 chuck attached. This lathe model is still available on the market brand new, on sale at £1150, or £1450 with the stand. This one will probably be £300 - £350.
- [Axminster Scroll Saw Excalibur Ex-21](#). (21" throat). Probably £60
- [Record DX1000](#) dust extractor. £140 new. Probably £60 - £75 depending on what fittings it comes with. It is well worth having an extractor for each machine in your workshop, if you have the space.
- [Trend Airshield Pro](#) respirator helmet. £310 new. Probably £100 depending on condition.
- A reminder that I still have a [Sheppach sliding mitre saw](#) for sale. Reduced from £100 to £75 (for a £310 machine) – I need some space in my garage!

Also someone in Malton contacted me on Saturday about clearing out her deceased husband's workshop. I don't know what is there yet, but I do know she has a lathe for sale. It is a [SIP900](#) – quite a large lathe, mechanical speed change, swivel head, 6" clearance above the bed, 36" between centres. Probably £200, possibly less.

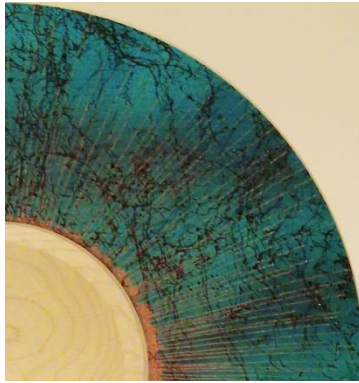

Which means I cannot keep going to workshop clearances and bringing back wood and equipment – especially larger items. They seem to have been a big success with club members, particularly the last two, helping you to kit out your workshops to a better standard. I don't mind continuing to go and see clearances and pick up items for sale at the club, but if any one can offer any storage space for wood and equipment (usually temporarily, between meetings), I would be very grateful.
