Houtdraaien in Noord-Engeland

This translates as "woodturning in the North of England". I had a visit from a Dutch woodturner, Flip van de Waardt, back in June, who asked if he could do an interview for a magazine he writes for in the Netherlands. Flip and his wife spent a couple of hours with us, talking about woodturning and gardening. 2 copies of the woodturning magazine *Aktie Radius* (Action Radius) came through the post on Friday, compliments of Flip. It is the magazine of the *Nederlandse vereniging van houtdraaiers*, which translates as the Dutch Association of Woodturners, and it is very similar in content and layout to our AWGB publication, published quarterly. They might have some interesting offcuts. I will let you all know what might be available from them in next week’s bulletin. I may buy some for the Club shop – let me know if there is anything in particular I should be looking for.
